

2026 SRC Elections Campaign Procedures and Guidelines

1. The submission of proposals for Rallies and Res-to-Res Campaigns for student structures / organisations and independent candidates, **opens** on the **17th of August 2026 at 08h00** and **closes** on the **24th of August 2026 at 15h00**.
2. All submissions must be submitted to the Student Development Officer via email: zwane.thabiso@mut.ac.za
3. The publication of approved Rallies and Res-to-Res and Campaign schedule for student structures will be on the 27th of August 2026.
4. All Rallies and Res-to-Res Campaigns will begin on the 28th of August 2026.
5. All Rallies and Res-to-Res Campaigns must be conducted between **the 28th of August 2026 the 11th of September 2026**.
6. The number of people who will be granted access into the Residences to conduct campaigns shall not exceed eighty (80) people in larger buildings and not exceed twenty (20) people in smaller buildings and shall not exceed two (2) people entering each room in a particular building.
7. Non-students will not be granted access into the Residences; student cards shall be produced at the point of entry at all times.
8. Once permission has been granted, notices informing students about proposed campaigns will be placed in Residences at least one (1) day before a proposed campaign.
9. The starting time for Campaigns per day is strictly **after 13h00** and the cut-off time for campaigns per day is **no later than 22h00**.
10. Noise is not allowed during the Rallies and Res-to-Res campaigns and that includes the use of sound systems. Those who are conducting the Rallies and Res-to-Res Campaigns should always bear in mind that there are students who are preparing for tests and other academic commitments / assessments.
11. Students who initiate campaigns shall take direct responsibility for any disturbance that occurs because of their activities.

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12. A student structure / organisation / independent candidate, should note that campaign activities should not overlap with similar activities that have been initiated by another student structure / organisation / independent candidate, in the same Residence. Student structures / organisations / independent candidates, are not allowed to enter the same Residence to campaign at the same time.
13. All individual students and student structure leaders / campaign organisers shall comply with MUT General Rules and Regulations for Students. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person and student structure who / which fails to comply with all applicable rules and regulations.
