

Make sure your vote counts

Before the 2026 MUT SRC elections, every registered student should confirm that their details on the **voters roll** are correct. It takes about two minutes and is done entirely online. This guide shows you exactly how - from signing in with your student email to saving your verified details.

What you'll need

- Your official student email - your student number followed by **@live.mut.ac.za** (e.g. 22450916@live.mut.ac.za).
- Access to that email inbox to receive your one-time code.
- About 2 minutes. Any phone, tablet or computer with internet.

How to verify - step by step

1

Open the verification page

Go to **mutsrcelections.co.za** and tap **Verify details** in the menu - or **Verify my details** on the home page.

2

Enter your student email

Type your official student email (your student number + **@live.mut.ac.za**) and tap **Send my code**. Only students on the voters roll can verify.

3

Enter your one-time code

Open your student email inbox - we have sent a **6-digit code** that is valid for **10 minutes**. Enter it on the page and tap **Verify code**. Cannot see it? Check your spam/junk folder, or tap **Resend code**.

4

Check and fix your details

Review your details on the roll - surname, initials, first names, student number, qualification, academic year and block. Correct anything that is wrong.

5

Confirm and save

Tap **Confirm & save my details**. You will receive a confirmation email that your details are verified. That is it - you are done!

Good to know

- The verification page only works while the voters roll is **open** for verification.
- Your code expires after **10 minutes** - just request a new one if it lapses.
- Changing your **student number** flags your record for the elections office to review, so only change it if it is genuinely wrong.
- Verifying does not register you to vote - it confirms the roll has your correct details so your vote counts on election day.
